The Department of History and Theory of Literature at the Faculty of Humanities of *Konstantin Preslavsky* University of Shumen invites you to participate in the **International Philological Biannual Collegium *Language and Society***, which will be held on **7 and 8 November 2024** in **Shumen**.

The Collegium suggests the following topics in the *Academic Research section*:

- * Language – event – context
- * Language – historicity - perspectives
- * Arts and language
- * Language and media
- * Language and modern paradigms of knowledge
- * The *dialogue* of the disciplines in the humanities
- * Bulgarian Studies Abroad

Within the framework of the Collegium, we plan a special thematic field *Bulgarian Studies Abroad*, which is an opportunity for established scientists, doctoral students and students from partner universities to present the achievements and trends for the future development of Bulgarian Studies abroad in the field of the academic research, education, translation and cultural exchange. The work on the thematic area is part of the initiatives of the Department of History and Theory of Literature under the National Scientific Program "Development and Popularization of Bulgarian Studies Abroad"

In the scientific forum, organized for the seventh successive time, we plan a Student Seminar, the aim of which is to enable prominent BA, MA and doctoral students in the field of humanities to present the results of their joint work with academic supervisors and consultants. The Seminar aims to build the relationship between faculty and students with an emphasis on teamwork and research management. The participants in the Collegium can be from different specialties or scientific fields.

For the Student Seminar we suggest the following areas:

- * literature – linguistics – media
- * linguistics and social sciences
- * literature – media – communications
- * language and visual arts
- * literature – history – philosophy

The scientific forum will be held in a hybrid form – with in-person and online participation. The presentation of academic results at the Seminar should not exceed **15 minutes**. In its work the Collegium welcomes the team research work and the active participation in the discussions.

No participation fee. The cost of residence is at the expense of the participant.

Applications for the participation of BA, MA and PhD students, accompanied by a summary, are submitted with the consent of their research supervisor or scientific advisor.
