ABOUT THE PRESENTER:



Prof. Dr. Habil. Hristo Kyuchyukov is an expert on Romani and Turkic linguistics and intercultural education, and last 30 years he has been teaching and doing research in Europe, USA, India, Russia and Turkey. He holds a Ph.D. in General Linguistics (Psycholinguistics) from the University of Amsterdam (1995), Ph.D. in Pedagogy (1998) and DrSc (Doctor of Sciences) in Theory of Education and Didactics (2002) from Bulgaria.

His main interests are Romani and Turkic (Balkan Turkish and Gagauz) linguistics, minority children’s bilingualism, intercultural education of minorities, migrants and refugees, educational and linguistic rights of Roma in Europe and around the world. Together with the American psycholinguist Prof. Dr. Jill de Villiers he has developed the first psycholinguistic test in Romani language in the world.

He has more than 800 publications in the field of linguistics, intercultural education, history, culture and language of Roma, migrants, refugees, human rights.
